Shall the Harrison County School District issue its bonds in the maximum principal amount of \$55,000,000 to raise money for the purpose of paying the costs, including the costs of borrowing, of purchasing, erecting, repairing, equipping, remodeling and enlarging school buildings and related facilities, and providing necessary water, light, heating, air conditioning and sewerage facilities for such school buildings and related facilities, including, but not limited to the following generally described project: (a) construct and equip new K-8 school on the east side of the District; (b) construct and equip a new middle school on the west side of the District; and (c) renovate, equip and improve all school facilities as necessary, including improvements to enhance safety and security?
